

Junior Livestock Auction

The Benton County Fair Junior Livestock Auction is administered by the Livestock Sale Committee and operates as a separate and independent entity for the Benton County Fair Association. All Jr. Exhibitors in the beef, dairy, swine, sheep and goat departments are eligible to participate in the Jr. Livestock Auction provided they meet the eligibility requirements of the Livestock Sale Committee as outlined below:

- 1.** Anyone doing anything, for any reason, to discourage anyone from participating in the auction could be permanently banned from the sale.
- 2.** All who participate must be a member in good standing of a Benton County FFA, FCCLA Chapter or a member in good standing of a Benton County 4-H Club.
- 3.** 4-H Cloverbud and others under nine (9) years old will not be eligible to sell.
- 4.** All Animals will sell premium only and remain in the possession of the exhibitor.
- 5.** No exhibitor may sell more than one (1) animal / entry in the Junior Livestock Sale.
- 6.** All Market animals must be free of restricted antibiotics and available for slaughter.
- 7.** All sale participants will be expected to attend a meeting in the livestock arena to receive final instructions for the sale. Time and date will be announced at the fair.
- 8.** Participants in the sale will be required to write acceptable thank you notes to the buyer/buyers of their animals as well as to persons responsible for the photographs.
- 9.** Participants should check with their superintendents for times, places, line-up for sale and other information that might be required before the sale. They should cooperate fully with the superintendents sale committee and workers to make the sale run smoothly.
- 10.** Animals will be returned to stall/pens following the sale and will be the sole responsibility of the exhibitors.
